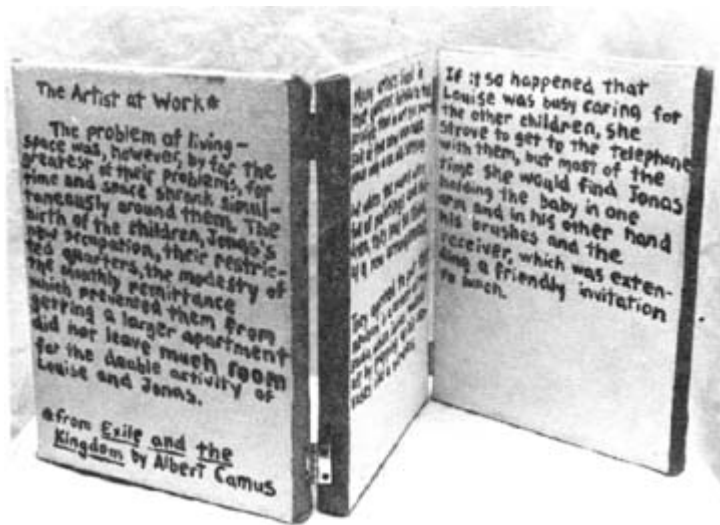

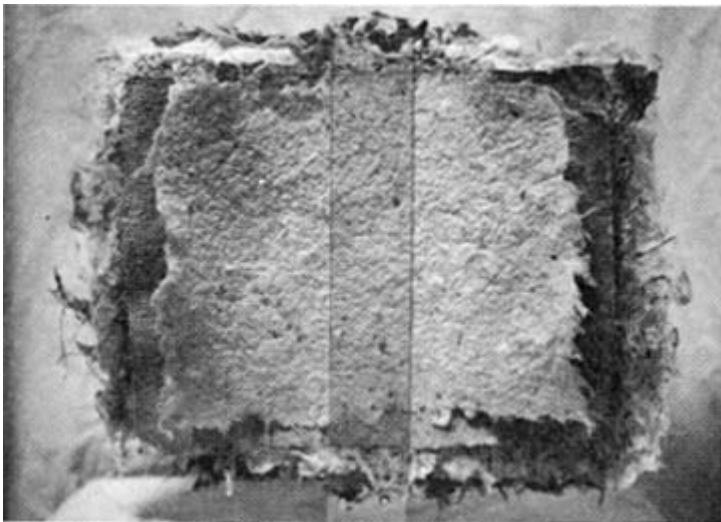
## THE ART OF RŪTA KONČIŪTĒ-SALIKLIENĒ

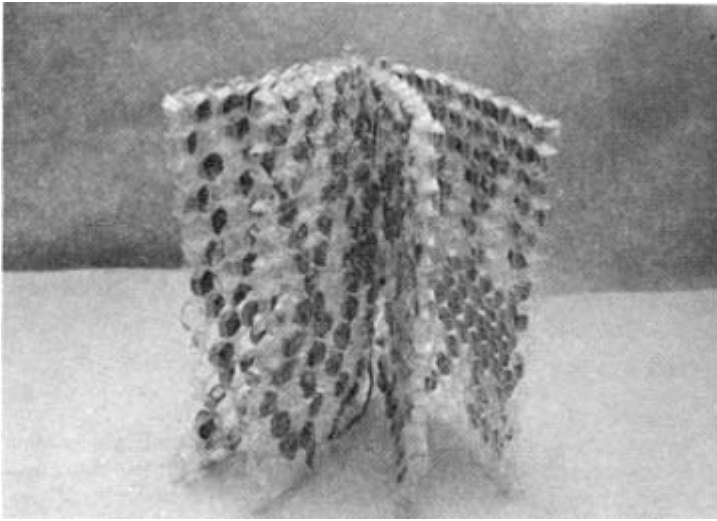
Broken childrens stories, 1986. Paper, alabaster, computer letters
